This spring, Manor Equine Hospital will again be offering Wellness Plans for our patients. These plans bundle wellness and preventive care services together at a discounted rate and include wellness exams, annual vaccinations, fecal egg counts, and additional services specific to your horse's needs. Clients wishing to purchase wellness plans should reference the plan information below and choose the level that's most appropriate for each of their horses.

ADD-ON SERVICES

Horses enrolled in Manor Equine Wellness Plans are eligible for the following add-on services at a discount. These services must be scheduled at the same time as a spring/fall wellness visit to take advantage of the discounted rate.

2026 MEH Wellness Plan Terms and Conditions

Basics

- 1) Horses enrolled in an Equine Wellness Plan are entitled to one spring and one fall wellness farm visit in the 12-month period following enrollment. The specific wellness services included in each farm visit vary by plan and are detailed in the charts above. Clients wishing to consolidate the Bronze Level Wellness Plan into a single annual farm visit can do so, but more than two annual wellness visits will not be accommodated with any plan.
- 2) Discounts offered through the Equine Wellness Plan program can only be applied to the enrolled horse.
- 3) Wellness appointments or specific wellness services that are not utilized during the 12-month enrollment term are non-refundable, cannot be substituted, and do not roll over.
- 4) A horse's wellness level cannot be changed during the enrollment term but may be changed the following enrollment year.
- 5) Add-On Services are available to help further customize plans but must be scheduled at the same time as a spring or fall wellness visit in order to take advantage of discounted rates.

Payment

- 1) Payment of the full plan cost will be due at the time of the first wellness visit. We accept cash, checks, and the following credit cards: Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express, CareCredit.
- 2) The total cost for each wellness plan covers all listed services for one horse. It DOES NOT include farm call charges, fees for Add-On Services, or charges for any other services rendered at the time of the wellness appointment.
- 3) Participants in the Equine Wellness Plan program can split call fees when appointments are scheduled together at the same farm.
- 4) If an enrolled horse is sold or dies while participating in the Equine Wellness Plan program, the remaining services can be transferred to another horse.

Enrollment

- 1) Enrollment for MEH Equine Wellness Plans will be open from **February 1, 2026 to November 1, 2026**.
- 2) To enroll, you can submit the electronic form found under the "Wellness Plans" tab on our website (www.manorequine.com) or you can call our main office at (410)472-3545.
- 3) Once you have successfully enrolled your horse(s), you must call our main office to schedule your wellness appointment(s) at your convenience.
- 4) Enrollment does not automatically carry over. Horses must be re-enrolled annually to continue taking advantage of the program.
